

Let dry.
Flip over and make the ledge by gluing the edge of the trimmed down stick about an inch below the crossbar.

Step Three:



Let dry.
Make an "A" by gluing two sticks together at the top and a half stick as the crossbar.

Step Two:



Eat four popsicles.

Step One:

Materials needed:

- 4 popsicle sticks*
- hot glue gun
- scissors or craft knife
- sandpaper (optional)
- paint or markers (optional)

*the sticks I use are about 4.5" long. I cut one in half and trim one down to about 4".

Step Four:

Glue the other half stick to the back of the crossbar at about a 20 degree angle.

Let dry.

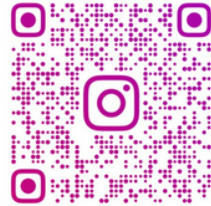


Step Five:
